Many individuals are familiar with the Hawaiian Lomi Lomi massage, but very few people are knowledgeable about the treatments from the South Pacific," says Sylvia Sepielli. "The spa also accentuates Halekulani's rich history and reputation for impeccable service by making the spa treatments the hallmark of guests' experience."

The spa offers guests a full menu of treatments, massages, body and facial therapies, organic hair and nail care services that are inspired by Hawaii's diverse heritage. Guests can select from the following three experiences.

- The *Elegant Passage*, a two and half hour odyssey, includes a massage of your choice (except for Pohaku) with steam shower and a facial. Guests also receive light refreshment on the spa terrace. Price is \$390 (service charge is included in price.)
- The *Grand Voyage*, a four hour journey, includes a massage of your choice (excluding Pohaku), a facial, deluxe manicure and pedicure. Price is \$490 (service charge is included in fee.)
- The *Heavenly Journey*, a four hour or more tour, incorporates a deluxe body treatment, massage of your choice (excluding Pohaku), and a facial. Guests also receive light refreshments on the spa terrace. Price is \$640 (service charge is included in fee.)
- *Romance Remembered at SpaHalekulani*, Embark on an intimate journey with a loved one. This elite package is designed to spark the bliss of romance. Your spa escape begins with our signature foot pounding ritual, followed by a couple's massage of your choice and duo custom "Just for You" facials. Unwind in our traditional Japanese furo while savoring complimentary champagne and decadent delights courtesy of our acclaimed Halekulani chefs. Side-by-side spa manicures and pedicures provide the perfect finishing touch to your shared retreat. Our deluxe SpaHalekulani amenity gift will inspire a lifetime of romance. (\$1,300 per couple).

Guests can also experience an array of massage techniques such as Lomi Lomi, Pohaku, Polynesian Nonu, and Swedish to name a few, at the spa facility or in the privacy of their suites. In addition, the spa presents guests with a signature line of facial and hair care products, as well as treatments featuring fresh island ingredients such as Lavender/Orchid, Papaya/Pineapple, Coconut/Passion and Maile.

SpaHalekulani's design evokes nostalgic feelings of an era long ago. It showcases art and artifacts from Hawaii and South Pacific. It also accentuates architectural elements from Pacific cultures such as the simplified design of a sliding Shoji Japanese door; wooden tropical grasses as window coverings in the Sudari-style; bleached tropical wood from Thailand; bamboo and tumbled stone pebbles from Thailand.

The spa presents guests with seven relaxation suites, including two tandem suites; one featuring a traditional Japanese Furo and the other, a deluxe shower for two. The suites are fully equipped with regular and / or steam showers, changing areas, personal storage, luxe personal amenities and private restroom facilities. The spa also offers two Murano Spa manicure and pedicure stations, a full service salon featuring Pureology, SpaRitual, Caleel + Hayden's GloMinerals, Maile Kauai, Bissinger's Spa Chocolates, Pure Inventions (antioxidant boosts), indoor and outdoor relaxation areas where post treatment refreshments are served, and a premiere retail store featuring spa inspired gifts.
